



## Cal Maritime Highlights:

- Member of the California State University (CSU) system on the water in Vallejo, CA.
- Conveniently located 35 miles North East of San Francisco, Ca.
- 850 students. Expanding in the near future. 80% Men / 20% Women. 600+ students live in Residence Halls on campus.

  - 32 teams make the National Tournament held every March in Sioux City, Iowa.
- Scheduling includes conference games in Northern California and pre-season trips to Maine, Oregon in 06-07 and New York in 07-08.

- New 39,000 square-foot athletics complex scheduled to break ground in 2010.
- Defensively we play an aggressive man to man and zone pressure defenses. We extend our pressure to full court.
